




Innovation and Commercialisation Structure




The SU Investment Committee invests via USE on a case-bycase basis in some of the spinout companies emanating from SU research. It usually takes the form of a co-investment.





SUNCOM

SUNCOM, a division of Innovus, is responsible for the 5th revenue stream of the University, its focus is on commercial income, excluding technology and intellectual property-related income. While SUNCOM income feeds back into the consolidated statements of the University, all our divisions are financially independent. The information below reflects the results of SUNCOM as well as Factory 209 (Pty) Ltd. a wholly owned commercial company. Stats for the period January 2023 unified August 2023.



INNOVUS Innovus is a division of Stellenbosch University that is responsible for technology transfer, entrepreneurial support and development, and innovation. Stats for the period January 2023 until October 2023.
